Can I apply?

- You must hold a **relevant degree** (minimum of 2:2 degree or equivalent). If you do not have a relevant degree you will need to have at least an A level in the subject you want to teach.
- **GCSE grade C or 4 in Maths and English.** Primary requires a grade **C or 4 in Science, Maths and English.**
- The right to work or study in the UK.

Training Course Highlights!

- **Duration:** One academic year (full-time)
- **Award:** QTS (with optional PGCE depending on pathway)
- **Structure:** 4 days per week of school-based experience across two schools, gaining front-line practical teaching experience.
1 day per week is spent gaining academic understanding about teaching and your chosen subject.
- **Financial Support:** Bursaries and scholarships available in priority subjects!
